- a. **Aberdeen Property**: Status: Catherine, Francine and I have reviewed various iterations of the contract, and it is off to the Attorney for comment. This is a partial list of what I've annotated and asked for modifications in, etc.
 - 1. We have asked specifically for atty to look at the proposal that CLAM would have sole-authority to extend contract after the initial 65 year vs having the IF have the ability to re-negotiate, re-consider the program, etc.
 - 2. We asked for more provision should we want to visit/inspect our property for reason
 - 3. We asked for clarification on CLAM insurance and asked that it be for replacement value (not 85%)
 - 4. We asked that there be more information pertaining to why they want the ability to give up the property if damaged
 - 5. We asked for at least 2 million in liability insurance
 - 6. We are asking that language pertaining to who/time frame for notifying us of matters of concern be modified to reflect that having such letters delivered to a PO Box and ten days to respond doesn't work for a volunteer organization and we struggled with the language for this, as we have no staffed office to which such things would normally be delivered
 - 7. The fees derived. Catherine is handling this matter, has communicated some solutions to CLAM **Proposed Action:** Reiterate the earlier vote to give the Executive Committee authority to approve the contract and the fee schedule for rent for the properties. This should be resolved by the end of March.
