  - i. Water quality testing conducted by Tomales Bay Watershed Council will be analyzed and reported.
  - ii. The Foundation is offering \$5,000 grants for student research in Tomales
    Bay
- c. State of the Bay conference September 29th at the IYC.
- d. Tomales Bay State is initiating the Tomales Bay State Park's Forest Health and Wildfire Resilience Project.
- e. There will be a hike on Feb 12th, led by the Native Plant Society
